Get Your Fill of **C O L O R** this Winter

If you've grown a vegetable garden, then you're probably already aware of the striking shapes and colors many of our edible plants have to offer. But did you know that several hardy vegetables also make great additions to fall and winter flower gardens?

Check out this list of common and not-so-common cold-hardy plants and think about adding a unique source of color - and food - to your flowerbeds this season.

Ornamental Cabbage and Kale (shown at bottom right) come in a wide variety of colors and shapes. Most varieties will last through February and will add textured purples, reds and whites to an otherwise drab landscape.



Swiss Chard (shown at left) produces tall, wide leaves and thick, pronounced stalks that reach up to two feet tall. Rainbow varieties will provide a mix of striking yellow, orange, pink and violet colors to your flowerbed.

Mustard may seem like an odd choice, but the "Red Giant" variety will create a wonderful show of deep red and purple that actually intensifies as the weather cools. This two-foot-tall plant has a spicy taste that is perfect for stir-fries, as well as deterring hungry deer and rabbits.
